CCW Updates & Reminders

- Providers should have received a reminder to submit your Appendix B - Closed Days, for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. If you are completing this document on paper, it is due back to the ELRC by 5/6. Providers using PSS have until 5/13 to complete their Appendix. You can view an instructional video [here](#). Reach out to your provider specialist with any questions.
- Providers are expected to report any co-pay delinquencies to their provider specialist by Monday of the following service week. Providers using PSS can report both the delinquency and when the co-payment has been satisfied.
- Co-pay changes occurred for many families in April. Please review your enrollment summary carefully to ensure you are collecting the correct co-pay in May.
- Look for more information regarding the upcoming School-Age flip which occurs on June 13th.

STAR Movement Tip of the Month

Did you know that OCDEL has a list of approved curricula and assessment tools?

STAR indicator EC3.4.1 requires providers to select and implement one of these approved curricula. A curriculum is an essential component to a quality program as it assists teachers in designing classrooms, planning activities and implementing developmentally appropriate practices. The assessment tool will inform teachers of the child's competencies so they may design learning environments to meet individual needs.

If you have not already implemented one of these curricula or assessment tools, it is strongly recommended to use ARPA funds to purchase these items. Your Quality Coach can assist you in selecting a curricula or assessment tool that reflects your program's philosophy, goals and objectives.

PD Registry

All licensed providers are expected to keep their PD Registry staff lists updated. When bringing on a new hire, make this part of your onboarding process.

The Director should go into the program's organization profile (on the Registry you will find this in the drop down menu under your name) and click on the employee tab. Click on the "manage invites" button. You can then enter the staff person's information including their personal email, job title and start date. The staff member will then need to accept the invitation and complete their profile.

When a staff person **leaves** employment, go back into your organizational profile and click on the employee tab. You will see a blue box with 3 dots. Click on this button to update. You will then be able to assign an end date to this employee.



Keystone STARS Planning visits

If you are a STAR 2, 3 or 4 program, your Quality Coach will contact you to schedule a **Planning Visit** approximately 6 months before your STAR expires. This visit with your Quality Coach is vital!

During a planning visit you will:

- Discuss your programs unique continuous quality improvement goals
- Organize and prepare for upcoming renewals and designations; setting timelines to ensure success.
- Hear the latest updates and opportunities available to you and your staff (upcoming grants, free ECE courses, etc.).
- Ask your questions and receive individualized attention catered to your needs and goals.

Child Care Technology Access Award

All eligible DHS certified child care providers, regardless of Keystone STAR Level, who are in need of technology tools can apply for this one-time award. This funding opportunity will be awarded in the form of a voucher to order approved materials from the Kaplan Learning Company. The award amount is based on provider type and licensed capacity.

Kaplan began sending emails to eligible programs on 4/20/22. These emails were sent from info@kaplanco.com.
