## Early Intervention (EI)

**Supports and services**: Designed to meet the individual developmental needs of children with a disability, as well as the needs of the family related to enhancing the child's development in one or more of the following areas:

- Physical development, including vision and hearing
- Cognitive development
- Communication development
- Social or emotional development
- Adaptive development

**Age level:** Birth to age 5

**Eligibility:** Children who have special needs due to developmental delays and disabilities are eligible.

## Infant Early Childhood Mental Health (IECMH)

**Supports and Services:** Free on-site services to that enhance the social-emotional development of children. Although services are requested regarding a specific child who is exhibiting challenging behaviors, consultation services are provided to the all. Typically, services are requested due to concerns regarding the following areas:

- Aggression
- self-regulation
- attachment
- communication
- social interaction

Age levels served: 6 weeks to 5 years of age and who are not yet eligible for kindergarten.

Eligibility: Licensed child care programs in Keystone STARS
