Continue your education while continuing to earn a paycheck.

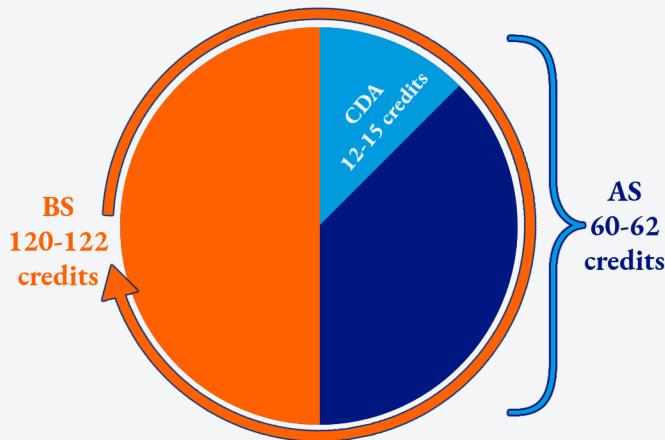
