Do you want to strengthen your relationships? Would you like to become more "coachlike" in your interactions with family, friends, and co-workers? Are you interested in changing the way you lead yourself and others? If the answer to any of these questions is "YES", then this training is for you!

Leadership coaching is a powerful tool that can improve skills, support change, and impact how we engage with and support children and families. You will gain experience developing or expanding your coaching mindset through being coached on real-life issues that can enhance workforce effectiveness.

This course will focus on the adaptive skills of aligning actions to values, and will build the critical thinking skills needed to support change and innovation in systems of care.

This training is open to ECE program administration and staff, OCDEL, Pennsylvania Key, ELRC, Certification, and EITA staff.

TOPICS COVERED INCLUDE:

- Becoming and staying present, even in the midst of chaos and conflict.
- Identifying an engaged listener and how to become one.
- Asking powerful questions that unlock deeper responses to leadership challenges.
- Using communication and feedback to support adaptive work.
- Building personal and collaborative accountability within teams.
- Using leadership coaching skills in daily interactions.
- Creating ongoing opportunities for internal and cross-system collaborations.
- Increasing effectiveness with the Coach Approach.
