Dear Preschool Teacher,


Community Services for Sight is once again providing FREE vision screenings to children aged 3-5. Children of this age level do not know how well these are supposed to see. We help to ensure the child is seeing at his or her best.

During the screening your student will have no physical contact with the screener. We use the Spot Screening from Welch Allen; this allows the student to stand on a designated spot and looking into what is essentially a camera. The screener stands 3 to 6 feet away from the student. It takes approximately one minute per child from start to finish. The device will present a reading to the screener and indicate a pass or fail based on the standard criteria for children of the 3-5 age level.

What sets us apart from others who offer screenings is our follow up process. If a child fails and is referred for a professional eye examination, we follow up with the parents to ensure the child has insurance to cover the cost of the examination and if prescribed, can afford glasses. If there is an issue with cost, we can assist in paying for what is needed to ensure the child receives proper care and devices. Our screener has been performing vision screenings for over 25 years and is certified in Prevention of Blindness, including preschool vision screenings.
