ELRC Updates

Work Force Support 2.0 Payments

Work Force Support Grant 2.0 payments will begin to be sent in January. Providers will recieve their payment via the same format (direct deposit or check) as their CCW payment. All awards will be sent no later than 3/17/23.

Staff Retention Award

These funds must be paid in full by the provider, through employer payroll, within 45 days of receipt of payment to the staff person for whom the funds were applied.

- If a staff person leaves employment before you recieve payment, these funds should be transferred to the Staff Recruitment bucket OR return those funds the the ELRC.
- If a staff person has given notice but is still employed at the time funds were recieved, the provider must pay the eligible staff person.

Staff Recruitment Award

These fund can be used for expenses from 7/1/22 - 6/30/23 related to recruting and hiring new staff but must be spent within 90 days of receipt of award.

Grant closure forms are due to the ELRC no later than 6/30/23. Closures should be emailed to <u>elrc-ksgrants@cscinc.org</u>.

CCW Reminders

Appendix I

The Appendix I (Attestation of Professional Development) were due to the ELRC by **December 30, 2022.** Any provider with an active CCW Provider Agreement

who did not submit their Appendix I by the due date, has had their agreement terminated and will no longer receive payment for children receiving subsidized child care. If you missed sending in your Appendix I, please submit it as soon as possible to your Provider Specialist so that your agreement can be reinstated.

Private Pay Rate Update

This past Fall, OCDEL requested that providers complete the Market Rate Survey. The rates submitted were then used to update each provider's rates in Pelican and COMPASS.

Providers who completed their Market Rate Survey should have received an updated C-2 form from the ELRC, listing your private pay rates. It is important to review this information and immediately report any inaccurate rates to your Provider Specialist. If your rates were updated, your CCW reimbursement rates may have been affected on your November invoice.

Registration Fees

OCDEL has announced that as of 1/1/23, certified child care providers will receive a registration fee for all newly enrolled CCW children. This registration fee will be automatically added to the provider invoice for the service period in which the enrollment was effective, regardless of whether the provider charges a registration fee.

Please note that providers cannot charge CCW families registration fees or the difference between what the ELRC pays for a registration fee and what the provider charges private pay families.

Certification Regulations Rewrite Project

The proposed Certification Regulations for Chapter 3310 (Family Child Care Homes) and Chapter 3320 (Child Care Centers) were submitted to the DHS Regulatory Review process in November 2022. OCDEL will move into the next phase of the Certification Regulation Rewrite Project which will be the Training and Resource Development Phase.

The Pennsylvania Equity in Early Childhood Education Champion Awards bring awareness to and highlight the equity work being done within Pennsylvania's early childhood education and afterschool settings.

Applications should be submitted electronically by the Feb. 1, 2023, deadline and can be submitted in English or Spanish.

Keystone STARS Update

OCDEL Approved Curricula & Assessment Tools

The optional requirements for STAR 3 and 4 providers to use OCDEL-approved curricula and development assessments in order to earn points in EC 3.4.1 and EC 3.4.2 has **not** changed in recent years. However, OCDEL recognizes these requirements may not have been communicated effectively or implemented consistently across the commonwealth. Effective December 1, 2022, only current OCDEL-approved curricula and developmental assessment tools will be accepted in meeting EC 3.4.1 and EC 3.4.2 for STAR 3 and 4 designations as outlined in this policy announcement.

Alternative Pathway Providers

Programs who hold accreditation through an OCDEL-approved Alternate Pathway accrediting body can apply for a Keystone STARS designation. The Announcement shares details relating to:

STAR Certificates

STAR Designations and renewals are now completed in the PD Registry. All STAR 2, 3 & 4 providers complete a 3-year cycle and are given a 3-year expiration date.

- Year 1 Evidence review
- Year 2 Renewal
- Year 3 Renewal

New STAR Certificates will now reflect the expiration date of your 3-year designation cycle. However, this three year expiration is contigent upon providers completing their annual renewal request in Year 2 & Year 3.

Health & Safety

Prevent Indoor Carbon Monoxide Poisioning

Carbon Monoxide (CO) is an odorless, colorless, and deadly gas that can cause headaches, fatigue, nausea and vomiting, visual disturbances, and confusion in children and adults, even at low levels. CO can cause serious illness, unconsciousness, and death at high levels. CO can be emitted from defective heaters, furnaces, and appliances that use natural gas, oil, kerosene, propane coal, wood, charcoal, or other products that can produce CO. The Department of Health recommends that childcare facilities install an UL-approved CO detector in the hallway near classrooms. CO poisoning is preventable with properly functioning CO detectors.

Providers are encouraged to take <u>DOH's Choose Safe Places Survey</u> to learn more about best practices to ensure staff and children under their care are protected from CO poisoning and other potential environmental hazards. Providers can receive a certificate of acknowledgment to display at their business for completing the survey.
