CCW Reminders

The ELRC financial books have been closed for the fiscal year July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024. Payments cannot be made on invoices for care prior to July 1.



School Age Flip - Back to School

The ELRC is preparing for the change in schedules for school-age children. The school age flip from full-time to part-time for all eligible school age enrollments, will take place on **Monday, September 2nd**. This will affect your attendance reporting and payments.

Email the completed form back to your provider specialist by: **August 16, 2024**.

The ELRC appreciates your support in communicating this need to your CCW enrolled families as well. Please remind them to contact their family specialist with any changes to schedules.

In addition, please check the August invoice and make any necessary corrections to schedules.

PA Department of Health Program visits for immunizations and resources

Beginning July 2024, DOH field nurses and local Municipality Department of Health field staff will visit randomly selected child care providers to offer immunization education and resource materials for staff and parents/caregivers. A review of child immunization records can be provided, if requested by the child care provider. If requested, a random sample of immunization records can be reviewed.

The field nurses and staff are very knowledgeable and should be seen as a resource in helping to educate you and your staff on disease preventable vaccinations for the health and safety of the children and staff within your facility. Take this opportunity to ask questions and request specific educational resources.

Additionally, DOH will be sending out electronic surveys to all child care providers regarding the immunization status of every enrolled child at their facility. These surveys will serve as the mandatory reporting requirements for child care settings outlined in DOH regulations **28 Pa. Code § 27.77**. [Immunization requirements for children in child care group settings](#). It is anticipated these surveys will be sent later this summer.

Supervision & Ratios

As you begin to plan your classroom enrollments and staffing for the Fall, be sure all rooms are fully covered to meet not only the ratios required, but the correct staffing components. Aides cannot be left alone with children so creative scheduling and combining of classrooms in the beginning and end of the day may be necessary. It is also important to factor in emergencies like staff illness or a child who needs temporary one on one attention. A floater or administrative support person who can help cover classrooms is necessary, especially for larger programs.

Setting Oral Health Goals

Goal setting can help you create new behaviors and it can also allow you to measure your progress. Goals also give you the motivation to maintain healthy oral health habits.

Healthy oral health habits include:

- Regular dental visits and treatment
- Healthy snacks
- Brush with fluoride toothpaste at least twice a day
- No sugary beverages



- No bottle for bed
- Water or milk only in sippy cups
- Drink tap water
- Avoid or limit junk food and candy
- Limit sugar and consider sugar substitutes
- Last thing to touch teeth before bed is toothbrush with fluorinated toothpaste
